Preservation 101

Thursday, February 28, 4 to 6 PM

The Fall River Library, 104 North Main Street, Fall River.

Directions to the Fall River Public Library, 104 North Main Street, Fall River

Please call (508) 496-7287 if you get lost. The library's number is (508) 324-2700.

From the north:

Proceed south on Route 24 to exit 6 (Highland Avenue).

Proceed straight past the traffic light at the end of the ramp and bear right at the gas station (you will still be on Highland Avenue) and continue straight on Highland Avenue until you reach Charlton Memorial Hospital (approximately 1.7 miles from the Route 24 ramp light) then bear right after the stop sign.

Proceed straight around the hospital (still Highland Avenue) for about 5 blocks until you reach a "Do Not Enter" sign on Maple Street.

Take a right at the sign on to Maple Street and proceed for two blocks until you reach Rock Street (the Fall River Historical Society will be on the left on the corner of Rock).

Take a left on to Rock Street and proceed straight for five blocks to Franklin Street until you see a large brick church on the right (now the International Institute of Culinary Arts).

Take a right on Franklin Street and proceed for two blocks. The main Fall River library will be straight ahead on North Main Street. Metered parking is available on the street.

The workshop is in the main meeting room downstairs.

From the east and south:

Take Interstate 195 west to the center of Fall River to exit 7-6 (Plymouth Avenue/Route 81 S/Pleasant Street).

When on the ramp, stay left to go to exit 6 (Pleasant Street).

At the end of the ramp, turn right on to Pleasant Street, then take an immediate left on to 7th Street.

At the end of the block, take a left on to Bedford Street. Proceed about four or five blocks to the third set of traffic lights (the Citizens-Union Bank will be on your left).

Take a right at the lights on to North Main Street and proceed for two blocks. The Fall River Public Library will be on your left on the second block. Metered parking is available on the street. The workshop is in the main meeting room downstairs.

From the west:

Take Interstate 195 east to Fall River to the first exit after crossing the bridge, exit 5 (Route 138 south). While on the ramp, take the first left that says (North Tiverton, RI) and proceed to the end of the ramp at Milliken Boulevard.

Take a left on Milliken Boulevard and proceed to the set of traffic lights. Proceed straight through the lights for one block and take a right on to Bank Street (the Armory will be on the corner fronting on Bank Street).

Proceed one block on Bank Street and take a left on to North Main Street. The library will be on your left. Metered parking is available on the street. The workshop is in the main meeting room downstairs.

From I-95 North or South take Exit 53A (Rt. 97 South) towards Topsfield. Follow Rt. 97 South for approximately 2.8 miles, bearing right at its intersection with Main Street. Proceed another 4/10 mile and look for the red brick library on the left at the lower end of the Topsfield Common. On-street parking only. Entry on right side of the building.

The meeting room at Greenfield Community College Downtown Center, 270 Main Street, Greenfield.

From the north, south or west:

From the I-91 exit to Route 2/2A traffic circle. Follow Rte 2A east (Downtown signs) to Main Street (approximately 2 miles). The GCC Downtown Center is next (corner) building on the left beyond Wilson's Dept. Store.

Directions from the east via Rte 2:

exit at Rte 5/10 and turn left to Rte 5/10. Proceed about 3 miles south to Main Street. Turn right (west) onto Main and the Downtown Center is at the end of the first block (corner of Main & Davis Streets) on the right (north) side.

To reach Davis Street from Main or Federal, take Ames Street: the first west side street off Federal and north of Main.
Go one block. The rear entrance to the Downtown Center is on the left before Davis.

Parking is on Main Street (free after 5), around the Common, behind the brick Town Hall facing the Common and behind the Downtown Center and Wilson's on Davis Street.

Brigham Hill Community Barn, 37 Wheeler Road, North Grafton

Directions from the Mass Pike:

Take the Mass. Pike to Exit 11 (Millbury, Rt. 122) and turn right onto Rt. 122 South. Proceed a little over 2 miles, during which time Rt. 140 will merge in from the left, and you will then pass under the Mass Pike. At the base of a down grade, look for Wheeler Road on the right. If you reach the Stop & Shop you have gone too far. Turn right on Wheeler Road. Follow Wheeler Road up the hill until near the point where it ends at North Brigham Hill Rd. You will see the farm on the left.
